TEESDALE DAY CLUBS

The Teesdale Day Clubs provide support to mostly, but not exclusively, elderly residents in Teesdale villages to combat isolation, improve health & wellbeing, and to provide a source of information and support. Clubs meet regularly, usually on a weekly basis and normally from 11.30am until 2.00pm.

Members pay £7.00 for a 3 course lunch cooked on the premises by a qualified Chef. All of the premises used have wheelchair access, either level or ramps and member transport can usually be arranged.

- Woodland Village Hall, every Monday 11.30 am to 2.00 pm.

CITB Operatives Level 1 Award Health & Safety in Construction Environment



UTASS is looking to offer training to be delivered by Durham Employment and Skills in Middleton, in preparation for the CITB Operatives Level 1 Award Health & Safety in Construction Environment. The eligibility criteria is 19+ and unemployed or low waged.

Trainees would need to attend UTASS for all 4 days from 9am-3pm between 21-25 October 2024 and is a requirement before the City & Guilds Exam on the 4th day Prepare for the HS&E test - CITB as they can't progress for the Green Card without an accredited Health & Safety qualification. Durham Employment and Skills also gives trainees full details about using the booking voucher to book the CITB test and the venues where they can do it. Once they have both test certificates (one from C&G in UTASS and one from CITB at a Pearson Centre) DES provide a follow on 1 day session, where they will also purchase trainees' Green Card. DES are also offering a £20 food shopping voucher at this additional session too, which would also be held in UTASS
